Introduction

We pride ourselves on the smart appearance of our children.

It is our academy policy that all children wear the academy uniform when attending Queensmead Primary Academy (including educational day visits), or when attending and participating in an academy-organised event outside of normal school hours (with the exception of residential educational visits and some day visits).

Uniform is compulsory and is to be worn every day.

We provide a complete list of the items needed for academy uniform in the prospectus pack, on the academy website and available from the main office.

The Queensmead Primary Academy colours for uniform are purple (jumpers/cardigans/sweatshirts) ideally with the Queensmead Primary Academy logo. These can be purchased via the academy website or from Uniform Direct on Humberstone Gate in the city centre. In addition, we specify white (polo tops/shirts/blouses) and grey or black (trousers/skirts).





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Aims and Objectives

Our policy on the academy uniform is based on the following aims and objectives:

- Promotes a sense of pride in the academy
- Creates a sense of community and belonging towards the academy
- Is practical
- Is smart
- Identifies the children with the academy
- Prevents children from coming to the academy in fashion clothes that could be distracting to the class
- Makes the children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance
- Is regarded as suitable wear for the academy
- Reflects the ethos and culture in the academy
- Is designed with health and safety in mind
- Reduces the risk of bullying
- Prepares pupils for secondary schools policies regarding the wearing of uniform

Jewellery & Make-up

On grounds of health and safety we do not allow children to wear jewellery in our school. Exceptions to this rule are:

- One pair of small ear-ring studs in pierced ears
- Small objects of religious significance.
- Simple watch

We ask children to remove these objects during PE lessons and games lessons to prevent them from causing potential injury.

Make-up (including nail varnish and false nails) is not permitted in the academy.

Hair Policy & Extreme Hair Cuts

The academy does not permit haircuts that could serve as a distraction from learning for themselves and other pupils (this includes bright or un-natural colours and shaved-in 'logo's or words).

Parents will be contacted and advised of the need to correct this. A record will go on file where this has been the case.

We advise that long hair should be tied up in braids or pony tails or held back with a plain head band. Items used to tie back hair should be in Academy colours (purple/grey/white or black) and be small and discreet (This is for everyone's health and safety during the academy day.)

A plain head scarf in academy colours is permitted for religious or cultural reasons.



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Footwear

Queensmead Primary Academy wants all children to grow into healthy adults. We believe that it is dangerous for children to wear shoes that have platform soles or do not support the healthy development of children's feet such as: flip flops, ugg-type boots, espadrilles or high heels. These are not permitted.

We require and expect all children to wear flat shoes or boots, plimsolls or trainer shoes at Queensmead Primary Academy as stated in the uniform list.

All footwear must be plain black with black soles (shoes or trainers). Any logo must be black.

Sun Hats/Caps (Legionnaires Style) should be brought into the academy for the summer months.



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PE Kit

Full, correct PE kit should be worn for all sessions of PE and afterschool sports. Information will be given at the start of the school year as to when PE lessons will take place. On these days older pupils will attend in their full correct PE kit. Some younger year groups may get changed into their PE kits during the school day. On these days, kit should be brought in a labelled bag.

Trainers and plimsols/pump type footwear should be used for PE lessons only.

PE is not optional. All pupils are required to undertake at least two hours of organized physical activity per week. Health and physical development is a key part of growing up and is specified directly in the National Curriculum and through Government advice.

All children are expected to participate fully in PE sessions unless they have a medical condition which prevents them from joining in.

If this is the case, a signed note from parents giving full details on the injury/issue will be required.



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PE sessions missed will be followed up and evidence may be requested.

The Role of Parents & Carers

- ❖ ***We require all parents/carers who send children to our academy to support the uniform policy.***
- ❖ ***We believe that parents have a duty to send their children to school correctly and appropriately dressed and ready for their daily school work and routines.***
- ❖ ***One of the responsibilities of parents is to ensure that their child is wearing the appropriate academy uniform that it is clean and in a good state of repair.***

The academy welcomes children from all faiths and backgrounds. If there are reasons why, for example, on religious grounds, parents want their child to wear clothes different from the academy uniform, the Principal and academy will discuss this directly with parents.

Monitoring & Review

Families Causing Concern

As outlined above our academy operates a full uniform policy and therefore requires all pupils to wear the full uniform every day. Any breaches of the academy uniform policy will be followed up.

Please see the attached letter that we send when we have concerns over the standard of dress. We take this very seriously so that all focus in our academy can be about attitudes to learning and progress.

Teachers and Teaching Assistants may check uniform on entering classes in the morning and may provide you with reminders directly in order that you have time to address this.
